The UML Literary Society is accepting submissions of prose, poetry, photography and artwork for the 2010 issue. All UML students, staff, faculty and alumni are invited to submit their work for consideration, although only students are eligible to read at the Jericho Brown event.

The deadline for submissions has been extended to **Feb. 8, 2010.**

PLEASE FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES BELOW TO ENSURE THAT YOUR SUBMISSION IS CONSIDERED FOR PUBLICATION:

- 1) Two hard copies of your work (word-processed, double-spaced) with no identifying information on the submission.
- 2) One electronic submission of your work--whether print or photography--to Offering@uml.edu. The subject line of your email should read "Your Name -- Offering 2010"
- 3) A cover sheet with personal and contact information: name, campus or home address, phone# and e-mail address, and affiliation with the university. This information should also be in your email. Again, please do not include identifying information (such as your name) on the submission itself. If a student or an alumnus, please indicate your major and year of graduation; if a faculty or staff member, please indicate your department and position. Submissions of multiple photos should offer a simple description of each photo (with titles, if the photos have them) in the cover letter to allow us to identify individual pieces.
- 4) Limit submissions of poetry to six poems; please limit prose submissions to no more than 3000 words.
